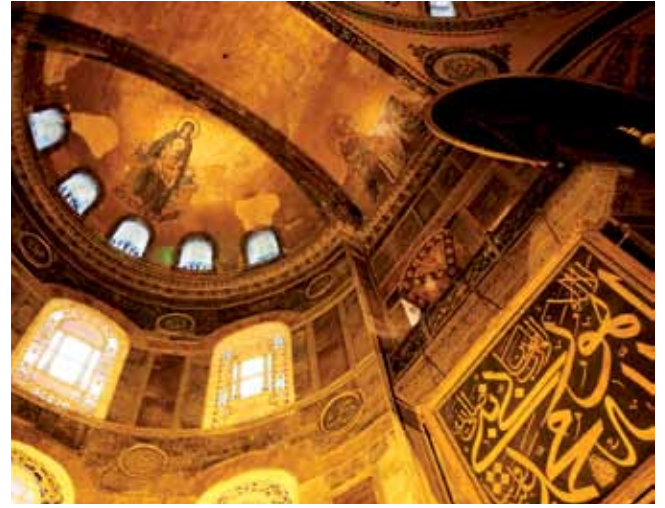

Short Course on Tribocorrosion

This introductory course to tribocorrosion is intended to familiarise students, young researchers, mechanical and chemical engineers, bio-engineers, maintenance responsible, material experts etc. with the basic and practical aspects of tribology, corrosion, and their combined effect on material degradation and protection issues.

It provides a well-structured approach of the scientific and technological basics needed to investigate the tribocorrosion behaviour of passivating materials. It explains how to conduct in a correct way a laboratory investigation on it, which experimental techniques are relevant, and how to analyse correctly the experimental data gathered.
